

N51. KEY TAGGING FOR SECURITY

Ellis Integral Valve Locks (148-150 Birmingham New Road, Wolverhampton WV46NT, United Kingdom) has developed a "color aware" control room key tagging system to enhance safety procedures based on key transfer.

Keys are coded with two holes to ensure that they can only be placed in the correct position in the cabinet. When a key is removed, the back plate is exposed and shows details of the area being accessed and the work being carried out.
