

### **N133. Planning For Ringhals 2 Steam Generator Replacement**

The replacement of the steam generators in Ringhals 2 took place during the summer of 1989. The plan work started in Vattenfall much earlier, already in 1982 with the first studies. This paper gives a general view of the radiation protection involvement from the start in the interplay through the engineering and construction between the contractor, Siemens/KWU, and Ringhals radiation protection organization in the steam generator replacement project.
