

N188. Improving Communications With Utility Personnel

EPRI has recently introduced new ways of informing ALARA-oriented personnel of technical developments in the areas of low-level waste and radiation control.

In the fall of 1991 a news service on EPRINET covering all aspects of low-level waste management was initiated. This service has now been extended to the area of radiation control. The "Radiation Control News Service" will summarize articles appearing in the EPRI newsletter, provide details of forthcoming events, and information on EPRI reports. It targets professionals concerned with radiation field control and exposure reduction. In 1992, the EPRINET start-up package is free.
