

N370. NRC Issues Favorable Inspection Report

A readiness assessment team has concluded that preparation at the Indian Point-3 nuclear plant are adequate to support a safe restart.

The team spent 18 days conducting more than 1,000 hours of direct inspection. They issued evaluations in four areas: 1) Management programs/independent oversight/self-assessment 2) Operations 3) Maintenance and surveillance 4) Engineering and technical support. The team concluded that the management expectations regarding safety had been clearly communicated. The corrective action process was effective in identifying and resolving issues. The oversight functions were effective. The team concluded that the management team, corrective action program, and oversight function are in place to support a safe plant restart.
