Since the worker is responsible to maintain his dose ALARA, ALARA campaigns help remind and provide incentive for workers to encourage dose reduction. ALARA campaigns have included items such as ALARA slogan/poster award, name of winner of ALARA slogan/poster contest on paycheck stubs, salary increase on ALARA performance, ALARA suggestion awards, contractor penalties, ALARA Employee of the month parking space, radiation safety talks, ALARA novelties (buttons, hats, T-shirts, pens), and ALARA signs/posters.
