Introduction

The Fourteenth Nuclear Utility Meteorological Data Users Group (NUMUG) meeting will be held at the Oak Brook Hills Marriott Resort 27 – 29 June 2011. The NUMUG Conference will be held in parallel with the EPRI Groundwater Protection Workshop and immediately before the 2011 RETS REMP Workshop. This technical meeting will include papers and panel discussion presentations, combined with ample opportunities for group and individual information exchanges, on meteorological monitoring and operations related to nuclear-powered electric-generating facilities. A preprint will be prepared in electronic format.

NUMUG Meeting attendance includes a welcoming reception with dinner on Monday night, lunch on Tuesday, breakfasts on Tuesday and Wednesday, and snacks during breaks.

- concerns related to proposed new plants;
- other applications for weather information within nuclear electric utility operations.
