2. Web Site: The issue of NUMUG having a web site came up since we were having the joint meeting with RETS-REMP's and they have a web site. Their site is managed through the North American Technical Center. NATC was formed to administer the International System on Occupational Exposure (ISOE) in North America for the OECD/NEA. NATC, which is housed at Purdue University, would administer a web page for NUMUG as they do for RETS-REMP. The design and management would be by NATC personnel, in consultation with

the Steering Committee, and when material needed to be posted to the web site, we would email content to them for inclusion on the site. It's a very easy process, according to the RETS-REMP people who were coordinating their meeting. The only cost to NUMUG is one free registration for a NATC person at our meetings. The verbal vote of the NUMUG attendees approved the Steering Committee proceeding with establishing a web site through the NATC.
