

An Introduction to the RETS/REMP Steering Committee

The RETS/REMP Steering Committee was established to provide for a body of personnel to help ensure the future success of the workshop and provide advice and guidance in the area of RETS and REMP. The duties of the steering committee include, but are not necessarily limited to, arranging for utility sponsors for each of the workshops, providing direction to the individual workshop sponsors regarding conduct of the meetings, ensuring that the workshop remains a professional forum for open exchange of information and ideas between utilities and various state agencies and the NRC, and developing nonbinding guidance in the form of position papers relative to questions or concerns in the area of RETS and REMP. The committee is comprised of approximately 8 utility members. These members will typically formally meet once per year at the time of the annual workshop. To date one position paper has been drafted by the committee. In addition, there are currently several subjects for consideration before the committee. Anyone interested in participating on the committee should inform one of the present members.
