## **Annual REMP Reports – Improvements?**

### **ABSTRACT**

Recent events in the nuclear industry have focused more attention on the information provided in the Annual Radiological Environmental Operating Reports (AREORs or more commonly known as the annual REMP report). Fukushima has heightened interest in REMP data. The National Academy of Sciences is interested in using data listed in these reports in an updated cancer study around nuclear facilities. Consolidation of ownership at many sites is leading to creating corporate model programs. New construction is underway at some sites. Changes in regulatory guidance (e.g., Regulatory Guides and NUREGs) are being evaluated. Many of us are considering retirement in the not to distant future. Let's take advantage of our experience and any new ideas from our new staff. These events indicate that now may be an opportune time to determine what improvements should be considered in our REMP reports.

The purpose of this presentation is to provide a brief discussion of several ideas for improvements (e.g., MARLAP data reporting, trending, general discussion items) and open the floor for a discussion of several of the more radical items.
